

Hansol Scholarship for
2019

Terms and Conditions

Background

On 14 February 1996 a joint venture was signed between Hansol and Ngati Porou Whanui Forests Ltd at Rahui Marae, Tikitiki, which is called the Ngati Porou Hansol Forestry Joint Venture. The purpose of the joint venture was to establish a 10,000 ha radiata pine forest on Ngati Porou land.

Hansol are an internationally recognised Korean forestry company.

Purpose

To demonstrate a commitment to support general community development but more specifically to develop forestry expertise and skill among Ngati Porou, Hansol are offering assistance to University or Tertiary Students who are direct descendants of blocks participating in the Ngati Porou Hansol Forestry Joint Venture.

Scholarships Offered

There will be two Forestry Scholarships of \$2,500.00 awarded in 2019. In the absence of suitable Forestry applicants the scholarships will be allocated as follows:

- Forestry Scholarship - \$2,500.00
- General Scholarship - \$2,500.00

Ngati Porou Whanui Forests Ltd will administer these Scholarships.

Eligible Courses

- **Forestry Scholarship.** The applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate forestry-oriented degree or diploma programme in New Zealand. Examples of eligible degree programs are:
 - B.For.Sc or B.E (Forestry) – Canterbury University
 - Diploma in Forestry – Waiariki Polytech
- **General Scholarship.** The applicant must be enrolled at a New Zealand tertiary institution (Polytech or University) in a complementary field of study to forestry development. Examples of eligible fields of study are:
 - Accounting and Business Studies
 - Management and Marketing Studies
 - Resource Management and Environmental Studies

Who can apply

To be eligible for either category the applicant must:

- Have direct whakapapa to the landowners of participating blocks in the Ngati Porou Hansol Forestry Joint Venture, and
- Be a tertiary student or enrolled to become one in the next academic year

Participating Blocks

Blocks participating in the Ngati Porou Hansol Forestry Joint Venture are: Ahiateatua A10C2, Akuaku A11A (Pohue A11A), Akuaku A11B, Akuaku A7B, Hakurenga, Harakeke, Hauturu A, Mangaoporo S8, Mangaotane, Mangatekapua, Mangatokerau 1C, Mautotara A, McClutchies (Omoana), Ngamoe A10A, Ohinepoutea B, Pakihikura A1, Pakihiroa, Parauamu A1, Pohutu (Whetumatarau B45B), Tapatu A1, Tapuaeroa A3B, Tarere 2, Taumataomanu A, Taurawharona (Maraehara B1D2), Taurewa, Tauwhareparae 1E, Tauwhareparae 1F (Paripoupou 1F), Tauwharerata A1, Te Rohe (Waipiro A34), Tikitiki A25 (Waihuka), Tikitiki D9, Tuhua, Turitaka A3, Tutuwhinau A2, Waiaranga A4A, Waingakia, Waipiro A29 (Kawa East), Waipiro A35B

Criteria

Selection will be based on academic merit and/or the ability to successfully complete the course of study and show a commitment to their whanau, hapu and iwi but more particularly demonstrate their commitment to working in the forest industry.

Terms and Conditions

The successful applicants will be required to provide end of year results for 2019.

Scholarship offers will be conditional on satisfactory academic performance. This means that students will be expected to have passed more than 75% of their course. For school leavers, preference will be given to those with NZQA Level 3 and will also be required to supply evidence of enrolment (fees receipt) before receiving scholarship funds.

The Scholarship will be paid in 2 installments of \$1,250 each with the first installment paid upon receipt of evidence of enrollment and the second installment paid after production of year end results.

Hansol reserves the right to withdraw any scholarships if there are insufficient applications in either category or if the Board believes that the standard of applications in either category is not of a reasonable standard. No reallocation of funds will occur.

Closing Date

Applications for scholarships must be received by Ngati Porou Whanui Forest Ltd's Office by no later than 31 May 2019.
